- ✓ No purchase necessary.
- ✓ Must be 18 years of age or older to participate.
- ✓ Participants must come into The Chester County Historical Society to complete a raffle ticket. The front desk clerk will guide you on how to fill out the ticket.
- ✓ Your ticket will be placed in our raffle box and you will be given the ticket stub (rules are also listed on the back).
- ✓ Prize is **one (1)** roll of quarters (\$10).
- ✓ Raffle runs from November 3, 2009 through November 2, 2010.
- ✓ One winner will be chosen each Tuesday from names entered the previous week and the winner will be contacted by phone or email (check back at our website each week for winning announcement).
- ✓ Winner must bring in their raffle ticket to claim prize.
- ✓ Winner not eligible to reenter raffle.
- ✓ Staff, volunteers, and Board members of CCHS are not eligible to participate.
